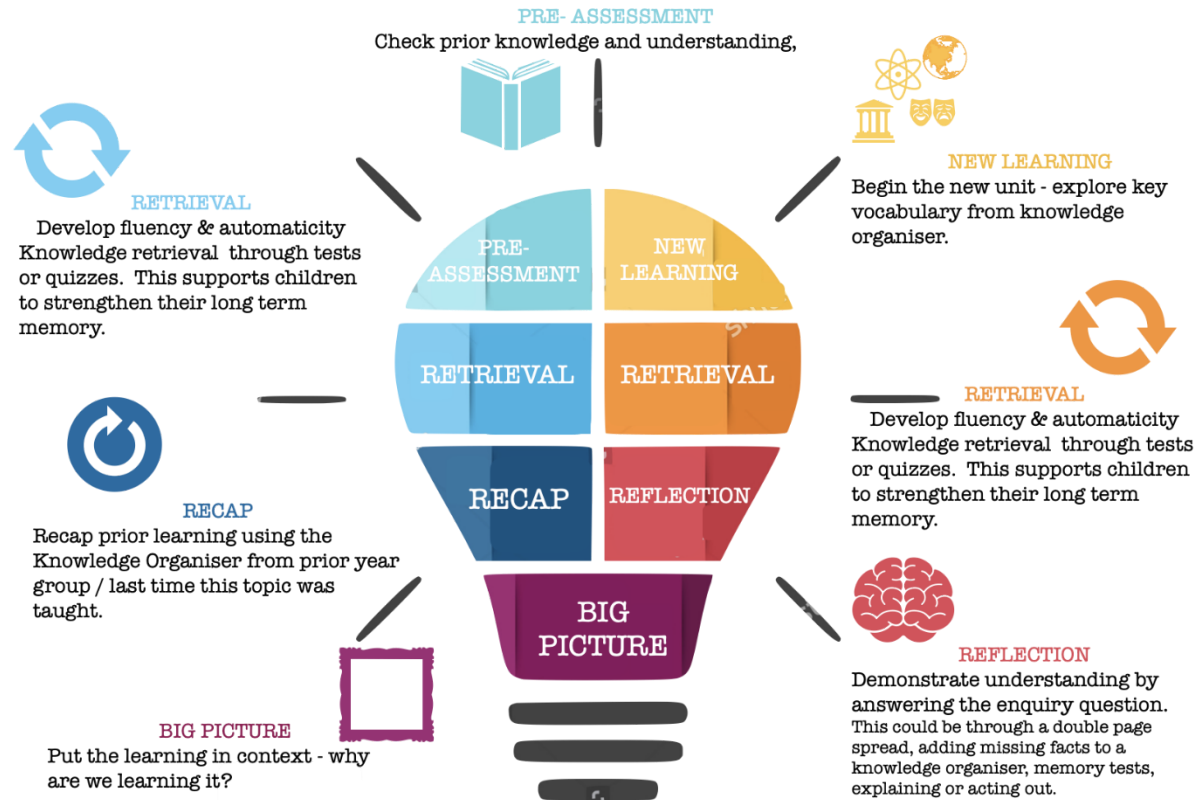

Autumn Term Ideas

Getting children thinking

- Who helps us every day?
- What does it mean to help someone?
- Why do people choose to help others?
- How can we help each other?

Exploring different roles

- Who helps us when we are ill?
- Who helps keep us safe?
- Who helps us learn new things?
- Who helps us if there is a fire?
- Who helps us when we need food?
- Who helps to keep our streets clean?

- Who delivers our letters and parcels?
- Who helps animals?

Encouraging comparison

- How are these helpers the same?
- How are they different?
- What tools or equipment do they use?
- What special clothes or uniforms do they wear?
- Where do they work?

PSHE

- How would you feel if there were no people to help us?
- When have you needed someone's help?
- How do you think it feels to help someone else?
- How can we say thank you to people who help us?

Investigation and problem-solving

- What should we do if someone is hurt?
- Who would you call in an emergency?
- Which helper could solve this problem?
- What might happen if nobody collected our rubbish?

- How do different helpers work together?

Role play prompts

- If you were a doctor, who would you help?
- If you were a firefighter, what would you do first?
- If you were a teacher, how would you help your class?
- What would you need to do your job?
- Which person who helps us would you like to be, and why?

Big enquiry question for the whole topic
